NEW CHURCH

In Rossendale is a populous and rapidly increasing chapelry, about $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles E by S from Haslingden, 8 miles S from Burnley, 9 miles NNW from Rochdale and 20 miles N from Manchester. The population of New Church, with the districts of Bacup, Deadwenclough, Tunstead and Wolfended, in 1801, was 5,046; in 1811, 6,930; in 1821, 8,557; in 1831, 9,196; in 1841, 11,668 and in 1851, 16,914. In 3 Henry VIII, there were only 80 persons in the forest of Rossendale, being only one family to each booth, or wooden house in which that family resided. In 4 Edward VI, or about fifty years afterwards, the population had increased to 1,000, and in 1650 the chapelry of New Church contained 300 families, and was then declared by the inquisition worthy to become a parish. In 1798, Bacup alone contained 306 houses and 1426 inhabitants. The great increase of the population in the chase of Rossendale is attributed to the establishment of the woollen manufacturers here in the time of Henry VIII, aided by the abundant supply of coal, the numerous quarries of freestone, and the strength of the water falls on the Irwell and its branches. The cotton and woollen establishments are now both numerous and extensive, as will be seen by the subjoined directory.

"The chase of Rossendale" says Mr Baines, "including Brandwood and Leach, originally members of it, contains not less than 25 square miles, or 15,360 statute acres. The name is probably formed from the British word *rhos*, expressing the dusky colour of the heath grass. In 4 Edward II, it was divided into eleven vaccaries, or cow pastures, of which the herbage was valued at 10s. In 22 Henry VII, the number of vaccaries, now called booths, had increased to nineteen of which the herbage was estimated at advanced rents, now varying from 13s to £13. Like the vaccaries of Pendle, these booths were the foundation of the townships, of which Dedquene Cloghe, now Deadwin, contains the hamlet of New Church, which gives its name to the chapelry. A lease of this booth was granted to James de Greenhalgh, which was attested at Lancaster, by Humphery, Duke of Gloucester, regent in the minority of Henry VI. In the reign of Henry VIII, Rossendale was disforested."

"The length of the parochial chapelry of New Church in Rossendale," continues the same writer, " is 5 miles, and its breadth 3 miles; it contains 6,125 acres, and is watered on the south by the Irwell, which rising at the foot of Dirplay Hill, in Cliviger, descends to Bacup by Broad Clough, and passing through Wolfenden runs by Tottigton to Bury. At the head of Wolfenden rises Whitewell Brook, which, having run its course, empties itself into the Irwell below the village of New Church," a term derived from the chapel or church, which being built in 1512, was the first place of worship erected in the forest of Rossendale. New Church, with the whole of Rossendale, is included in the manor of Accrington, and the Duke of Buccleugh is the feudal owner. The land is copyhold of the honor of Clitheroe, and the expense of an officer called 'the Greave of the Forest' appears to have been borne by four principal householders in each booth in rotation, since the year 1557.

The present church, which as well as the original, is dedicated to St Nicholas, was raised in 1825 partly at the cost of the parishioners and partly by a government grant. It is a neat structure in the Elizabethan style of architecture, which lances windows and a handsome square tower, in which are inscribed the initials of Queen Elizabeth, and the date 1561. The interior consists of a nave, aisles, and choir, and contains 900 sittings of which 227 are free – rendered so by means of a grant from the Society for Enlarging and Re-building Churches and Chapels. In the east window are the armorial bearings of Lawrence Lord, of Booth Fold, who died in 1825.

The living is a perpetual curacy in the gift of the vicar of Whalley, and incumbency of the Rev John BW Phillips. St Nicolas' National School is a handsome building near the church, erected in 1827 at a cost of £800, of which sum £500 was given by Robert Howarth Esq, of Warth. It will accommodate £500 (sic) scholars, and is now taught by Luke and Elizabeth Hoyle.

The Wesleyan Methodist chapel at Newchurch, erected in 1804, at a cost of £700, will hold about 500 persons. Robert Howarth Esq, of Warth, contributed £450 towards the erection of the Sunday School attached to this chapel. The Unitarian chapel, built in 1808, at a cost of £803, will accommodate 300 persons, and is now under the ministry of Rev George Hoade. The Baptists have chapels at Clough Fold, Rev WE Jackson; Waterbarn, Rev John Howe; and at Lumb built in 1828, Rev Samuel Jones. The chapel at Clough Fold was first built in the year 1700, and was once under the ministry of the celebrated Dr Isaac Watts. It was rebuilt and enlarged in 1838, and again enlarged and much beautified in 1853, at a cost of £1,500, exclusive of the superb pulpit of highly polished rosewood, the gift of Mr R Priestly. It is now a spacious and beautiful Grecian building, capable of seating about 1000 persons, and was re-opened for public worship the 13th of July 1853. Mr Thomas Risely, of Manchester, was the architect. The chapel at Waterbarn was erected in 1847, at a cost of £1,500, and will accommodate 600 hearers. There is a day school in connexion with this chapel, erected in 1840, at an expense of £500. The Baptists also have a day and Sunday School at Waterfoot, erected n 1850, at a cost of £300. They have likewise chapels at Dirpley and Gambolside.

The Wesleyan Association chapel at New Church, built in 1836, at an expense of £800, will seat 400 persons, and is now under the ministry of Rev James Edgar.

The Free Grammar School at New Church was endowed by sir John Kershaw, of Wolfenden, who, in 1701, bequeathed estates at Heald in Bacup Booth, for that purpose. Young gentlemen are prepared for universities at this school, which is now very efficiently conducted by Mr William Greenwood, BA, assisted by an under master.

At Stacksteads is a handsome church, with an octagonal tower, erected in 1840, at a cost of £2,000. It is dedicated to the Holy Trinity, and will seat 700 persons. The Rev John G Haworth is the incumbent of this church, which has in connection with it, a National School at Tunsteads, erected in 1841 at an expense of £1000, and also an Infant School held in a room at Stackheads. (sic). The National School will hold 500 scholars, an dis now taught by John Rawstron and Jane Bibby.

Fairs are held at New Church on the 29th of April for cattle, and on the first Monday after Midsummer, for cattle, pigs, pedlery, &c. The rateable value of New Church, Deadwin Clough, Tunstead, Wolfenden, Wolfenden Booth, and Bacup Booth is £35,098 17s 3d, and the principal land owners are George Hargreaves Esq, New Church, George Ormerod Esq, Fernhill, the executors of the late William Stanley, Esq, Broad Clough and Tanner Law, Esq.

Rossendale Forest or Chase, situate in the southern part of the hundred of Blackburn, was anciently spelled Rossendale, and previous to its being disforested, which is supposed to have been in the reign of Henry VII, was so thickly studded with large forest trees interspersed with rose bushes, that a squirrel might easily leap from one to another with out alighting on the ground, from Newhall Hey to Sharneyford, a distance of four miles. The district is exceedingly romantic, and very healthy, as is proved by the longevity of its inhabitants. A rental of £137 13s 4d was paid in the time of Henry VII, for the whole of the forest, whilst now an acre of land at Newchurch is said to have realised £240 a year.
